<b>Out &amp; about</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Talking about places in the neighbourhood/city using simple words</li> <li>• Providing basic description of a place or a location.</li> <li>• Understanding/Following basic instructions.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The verb <i>estar</i></li> <li>• Basic prepositions of place.</li> <li>• Simple expressions to ask about places: (e.g., <i>Disculpe, ¿dónde está el parque?</i>)</li> <li>• Basic expressions to give instructions (e.g., <i>Camine 10 minutos...</i>)</li> </ul>
