Family & friends	<ul> <li>Introducing &amp; giving basic information about a friend/family member (name, nationalities, occupations, relationship)</li> <li>Providing basic description of others using simple words/fixed expressions</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Simple expressions to ask for/give personal information (e.g., <i>I-reum-i mwo-ye-yo</i>? - What is your/his/her name?; <i>Jeonhwa beon-ho-ga mwojeyo</i>? - What is your phone number?)</li> <li>Cardinal numbers: 1-10</li> <li>Simple expressions to introduce &amp; describe others (e.g., <i>I/cheo sa-ram-eun che eo-meo-ni-ye-yo</i> - This is my mother)</li> </ul>
Out & about	<ul> <li>Talking about places in the neighbourhood/city using simple words</li> <li>Providing basic description of a place or a location.</li> <li>Understanding/Following basic instructions.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Basic prepositions of place (1) (e.g., Ap-jjok-e-In front of; Tui-jjok-e - Behind)</li> <li>Simple expressions to ask about places: (e.g., Hwa-jang-sil-i eo-di-e i-sseo-yo? - Where is the toilet?)</li> <li>Basic expressions to give instructions (e.g., Chi-ha-ch'eol t'a-go ka-yo - Go there by subway).</li> </ul>
Going places	<ul> <li>Understanding simple numbers</li> <li>Asking and Telling time &amp; day of the week</li> <li>Understanding a simple bus/train timetable</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Basic prepositions of place (2) (e.g., <i>Oen-ijok-e</i> - On the left of)</li> <li>Simple expressions to talk about arrival &amp; departure times.</li> <li>Basic expressions to buy a ticket (e.g., <i>Eol-ma-ye-yo?</i> - how much is it?; <i>Sam-man-won-i-e-yo</i> - It's 30,000 won)</li> </ul>

Coffee anyone?	<ul> <li>Understanding a simple menu</li> <li>Making simple drink &amp; food orders</li> <li>Using basic language to ask about food &amp; drinks</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Basic expressions to order a drink/a simple meal (e.g., Sam-gye-t'ang ha-na chu-se-yo - Please give (me) one chicken &amp; ginseng soup; Yeo-gi i-sseo-yo - Here it is.)</li> <li>Simple expressions to describe food-drinks (e.g., Mashissoyo - It is tasty)</li> </ul>
