<b>Out &amp; about</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Talking about places in the neighbourhood/city using simple words</li> <li>• Providing basic description of a place or a location.</li> <li>• Understanding/Following basic instructions.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The verbs in <i>imperativ</i>.</li> <li>• Basic prepositions of place.</li> <li>• Simple expressions to ask about places: (e.g., Ursäkta, var ligger?, var är?)</li> <li>• Basic expressions to give instructions (Gå till höger vid banken)</li> <li>• Instructions in you and "one" form (Du går framåt or man går vänster)</li> </ul>
