<b>Places</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Talking about the location of a person or building</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Subject marker: -이/가</li> <li>• 'to be at/in' (place): (장소)에 있어요</li> </ul>
<b>Numbers</b> ( <i>Sino-Korean</i> )	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Asking/Telling for a telephone number</li> <li>• Making a phone call and inquiring by telephone</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Sino-Korean numbers: 일, 이, 삼, ...</li> <li>• 'How much is-?': 얼마예요?</li> <li>• 'What / which number': 몇번</li> <li>• 'What / which date': 몇 월 며칠</li> </ul>

<b>Activities II Projects</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Talking about daily life and plans for the week</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Object marker: -을/를</li><li>• Informal polite style - present tense: -아/어요</li><li>• 'at, in': -에서</li></ul>
<b>Past Events</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Talking about past events</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Informal polite style - past tense: -았/었어요</li><li>• 'not': 안</li><li>• 'also, too': -도</li></ul>
<b>Location</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Talking about the location of an object or a building</li><li>• Giving the reason for going somewhere</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• 'on, under, in front of, behind, beside, between': 위, 아래, 앞, 뒤, 옆, 사이</li><li>• 'To go/come in order to': -으러 가요/와요</li></ul>
<b>Transportation</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Asking how to use public transportation and how long public transportation takes</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• 'by' (means of): -으로</li><li>• 'Please do/do not': -으세요</li><li>• '-from -to': -에서 -까지</li></ul>
