Basic words/expressions to show the location (e.g., Café no tonari desu – It's next to the cafe)

Dining out	 Understanding a simple menu Understanding basic expressions used at a restaurant Making simple drink and food orders Asking for the bill 	 Simple words/expressions to point to an item (e.g., Kore, Sore & Are - this, that & that one over there) Basic expressions to order a drink/a simple meal (e.g., Hanbaagaa o kudasai – Can I have a hamburger, please?) Ordering amounts of food and drinks Greetings when you eat
Travelling	 Asking and Telling time Asking about public transport using simple words/formulaic language Purchasing a bus/train ticket using formulaic language Understanding basic expressions used in transportation 	 Time (e.g., Nanji desuka - What time is it?) Basic expressions to buy a ticket (e.g., Ikura desu ka - how much is it?) Simple expressions to ask about transportation (e.g., Nanbansen desuka? – Which platform is it?)
Shopping	 Understanding big numbers/prices for shopping Understanding basic expressions used in shopping 	 Basic question words/expressions to ask the price and buy Simple words to describe items Counting of items Cardinal numbers (1-10,000)
