Out & about	 Talking about places in the neighbourhood / city using simple words Providing a basic description of a place or location Understanding / following basic instructions 	 Basic prepositions of place (e.g., <i>Dietro</i> – behind) Simple expressions to ask about places: (e.g., Scusi, dove sono i negozi? – Excuse me, where are the shops?) Basic expressions to give instructions (e.g., <i>Dieci minuti a piedi</i>It's a 10-minute walk)
Going places	 Understanding simple numbers & dates Asking and telling the time & day of the week Asking about / telling arrival and departure times 	 Basic prepositions of place (2) Simple expressions to talk about arrival & departure times (e.g., <i>A che ora parte il prossimo treno per Roma</i>? – What time does the next train for Rome leave?) Basic expressions to buy a ticket (e.g., <i>Un biglietto per</i> - A ticket to)

Understanding a simple menu Making simple drink & food orders Using basic language to ask about food 	 Simple expressions to describe food / drinks (e.g., <i>Il gelato è buonissimo</i> The ice-cream is delicious) Basic expressions to order a drink / a simple meal (e.g., <i>Prendo</i>I'll have)
